Gender Identity Policy

We support all our students on their journey toward self-knowledge, and we provide resources for any student with questions about gender identity. We are a school that empowers women. And we welcome those students who do not conform to society's traditional expectations of gender. We provide accommodations -- consistent with our identity as a school for girls -- for our non-binary or transgender students. If the accommodations we are able to provide do not meet that student's needs, we will work to find a placement for that student in a suitable school. At all times, we will be guided by the best interests of the student and the school community.
