



## Sleepaway@SEM & SleepawayINTL@SEM Camper FAQ

Question: What do I need to bring to camp?

Answer: The packing list will tell you exactly what you need. You can always ship packages in advance to SEM.

Question: When will I choose my courses?

Answer: You will have an opportunity to put your course request in after you register for Sleepaway@SEM/SleepawayINTL@SEM and all necessary documents have been received.

Question: What will I do during the weekends?

Answer: Our weekends will be filled with day trips to amusement parks, aerial parks, beaches, trips to see waterfalls, college and University visits as well as exploring the Greater Niagara region.

Question: Can I make a roommate request or request to be in classes with a friend?

Answer: Yes, you can certainly make one request, however we cannot guarantee that you will be able to be with your friend, as there are many considerations with course scheduling and roommate selection.

Question: Will international students be integrated with American students?

Answer: Yes, absolutely! International students will live in shared dorms and take classes with American students. If they are an ESL student their English instruction will be with all non-native English speakers, however all other courses, meals and camp activities will be with American students.

Question: Do campers need a student visa?

Answer: No, Immigration regulations allow for short term camp attendance with a tourist visa or visa waiver.

Question: How can my daughter get to and from the Buffalo Niagara International Airport to Buffalo Seminary?

Answer: SEM will have one pick-up and drop-off at the Buffalo Niagara International Airport on the official date of arrival and departure. This will be communicated to residential families after they register for camp.

Question: What about health insurance while my daughter is in the U.S. at SleepawayINTL@SEM?

Answer: All International campers will be required to submit proof of satisfactory health insurance. Health insurance may be purchased through the school at an additional fee.

Question: Can I have my cell phone?

Answer: Yes, but it will be checked at the camp office and you will use it with a counselor's permission and on any weekends that you might be with us.
